#### MISSIONARY COOPERATIVE PLAN

Please recall that each parish and mission is required to accept the missionary assigned every year by the Mission Office through the Missionary Cooperative Plan. The missionary is to talk at the Masses and take up a collection. The parish is to send the money to the Mission Office at the chancery for forwarding to the missionary society/diocese.

Please try to avoid World Mission Sunday, which is the second-to-last weekend in October, when assigning the missionary.

No parish is required to accept other missionaries to make appeals at the parish during the year. In fact, great caution should be used before agreeing to allow other missionaries to make an appeal, as they can have a negative effect on the success of the Missionary Cooperative Plan if parishioners feel they are asked too often to contribute to missionary endeavors. If another missionary is allowed to make an appeal, the collection is NOT to be given directly to the missionary. The money should be sent to the Mission Office in the chancery for forwarding to the missionary society/diocese.

Please be aware that some organizations not linked directly to the Church might aggressively approach you requesting to make a presentation or mission appeal during the weekend, while offering a priest to help you with the celebration of Mass. Some of these organizations have a checkered past and/or will inundate your parishioners with additional and excessive appeals for donations. Exercise caution as to whom you invite to your parish to make and appeal or presentation. Any special concerns should be brought to the attention of Hilda Ochoa, director of the Mission Office.

#### **BORROWING VESTMENTS**

Any parish wishing to borrow vestments needs to contact the Office of Worship and the Co-Cathedral Staff a month prior to needing the vestments. This will give ample time to prepare to loan them out, making sure vestments are clean and available for use.

### ANNOUNCEMENT - OFFICE OF THE GENERAL COUNSEL

Since the announcement of John Sieger's retirement as General Counsel. Archdiocese has been involved in a search for his successor. I am very pleased to inform you that the Honorable Frank Rynd has accepted the position of General Counsel. Judge Rynd has been on the bench in the District Courts of Harris County, Texas since 1998 and has served as an Administrative Judge in the Family Law Division. Prior to his public service, he was the General Counsel and Corporate Secretary for the Houston Sports Association (which included Astrodome USA and the Houston Astros Baseball Club) for 17 years.

Judge Rynd holds Bachelor of Arts and Law Degrees from the University of Texas. He is also a graduate of Strake Jesuit College Preparatory and a parishioner of St. Anne's Parish in Houston.

Effective September 15, 2010, Judge Rynd will assume the position of General Counsel. We are very grateful to John Sieger for his years of service to the Archdiocese and his continued willingness to be of assistance in sharing his legal expertise in the period following his official retirement.

To all priests:

My brother priest:

In September 2008 the Archdiocese sustained major damage from Hurricane Ike. All properties in Galveston were flooded, some were destroyed and many properties on the mainland sustained serious wind damage. The cost exceeds \$26,000,000 and while recoveries from insurance, FEMA and other resources have been considerable, the financial impact from uninsured losses was large.

Our current insurance program provides windstorm coverage (subject to a 3% per building named storm deductible.) However, flood insurance coverage is limited. Going forward, the high cost of flood insurance, more restricted insurance coverage to coastal areas and questions concerning the future of the NFIP program itself make it essential for us to prepare for the next storm.

In 2009 we established the Archdiocesan disaster fund to cover future uninsured property losses. The goal was to create a \$ 10,000,000 fund to be used for the payment of uninsured losses from natural disasters. We are pleased to report that, as of June 30, 2010, the fund balance, which is on deposit in a restricted Catholic Endowment Fund account is \$ 2,500,000. Thank you for supporting this program despite the weak economy and the many challenges that we face.

With the start of the 2010 Hurricane Season we have reintroduced the Archdiocesan Disaster Plan, with the current focus on hurricane preparation and response. Each parish should now have a Disaster Coordinator. We have held four training sessions and have run a successful initial test of our disaster communications network. We also continue our ongoing flood mitigation initiative, which includes the elevation of mechanical equipment, improved drainage, the use of portable flood barriers, and other measures.
