Parishes are encouraged to have a separate program for adult Catholics seeking to be confirmed. The Adult confirmations will be on Pentecost Sunday, June 12, 2011. Priests do not have the faculty to confirm an adult unless they are being received into the church (by baptism or profession of faith) at the same ceremony.

To: All Pastors

My brother priest:

In the 25th chapter of the Gospel of St. Matthew, Our Lord states very clearly that an essential element of the mission of the Church is to provide the basic necessities of life to our brothers and sisters in their time of need. Clothing the naked, feeding the hungry, visiting the sick and imprisoned and welcoming the alien is required to be a faithful follower of Jesus.

Each parish of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston does much to address the needs of the people who live within their area. However, there are many people whose needs cannot be met by the parish alone. For this reason the Archdiocese supports archdiocesan-wide social service agencies like Catholic Charities, San Jose Clinic and St. Vincent de Paul Society, to name a few.
